

ORDINANCE NO. 08-590

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TAX LEVY (MILLAGE RATE) FOR THE YEAR 2008 ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PORT RICHEY AS SHOWN BY THE 2008 ASSESSMENT ROLL; ESTABLISHING THE MILLAGE RATE AT 3.9000%, WHICH IS AN 8.66% DECREASE FROM THE ROLLED BACK RATE OF 4.2696% AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Port Richey, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. LEVY OF 2008 PROPERTY TAXES.

- A. For the year 2008, there is hereby levied a tax of 3.9000 mills (which is an 8.66% decrease from the rolled-back rate of 4.2696%) upon each \$1.00 value upon the 2008 tax roll. The same is hereby made upon all property, except such property as is exempt from taxation under the Constitution and Laws of the United States of America and the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, within the corporate limits of the City of Port Richey as shown by the 2008 assessment roll.
- B. The proceeds of this levy shall be used by the City of Port Richey for general expenses of operating and maintaining the City government in accordance with the budget for the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 as approved and adopted by the City of Port Richey, Florida.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
